



The Academy was first registered by NZQA in 1991 and is the oldest registered tertiary dive provider.





Successful completion of the diploma qualification will see you trained to enter the dive industry as a competent and confident PADI speciality instructor, with a qualification that will provide essential skills in confidence building, teamwork and leadership, that can be applied to a variety of outdoor pursuits.

You'll complete at least 100 dives, both in the Bay of Plenty and at other amazing dive sites throughout New Zealand. Our Students get free access to our high quality hire equipment during the course year, and can even make use of it during their free time and weekends (conditions apply).





New Zealand Certificates in Diving

These New Zealand Certificates are designed to guide the non-diver safely through basic scuba diving, advanced scuba diving, specialities such as night diving, wreck diving, deep diving, boat diving and search and recovery.

Both full-time and part-time study options are available at each of the levels. As a graduate you may choose to either continue tertiary studies, or utilise your newly acquired skills and work within the dive and outdoor recreation industries.

Once certified as a PADI Divemaster you will have access to the PADI employment page with new jobs advertised around the world daily.

Prerequisites:

Students must be at least 18 years of age, or turn 18 years of age by the time we get to PADI Divernaster training. Students must obtain a diving medical clearance prior to course commencement.
